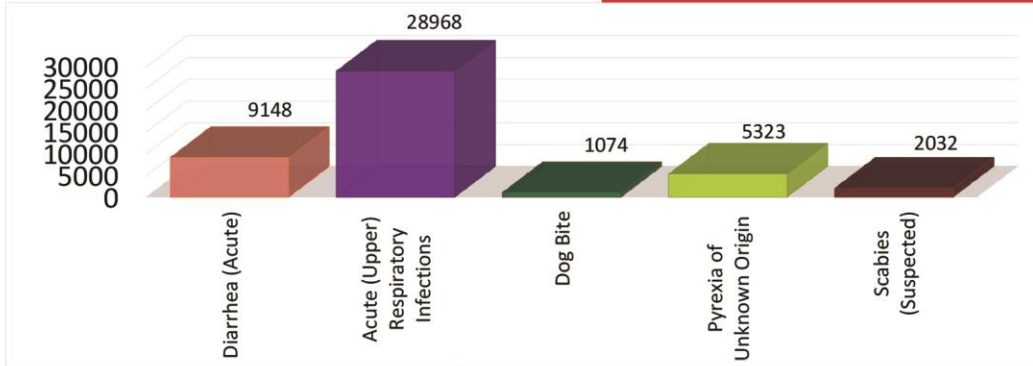

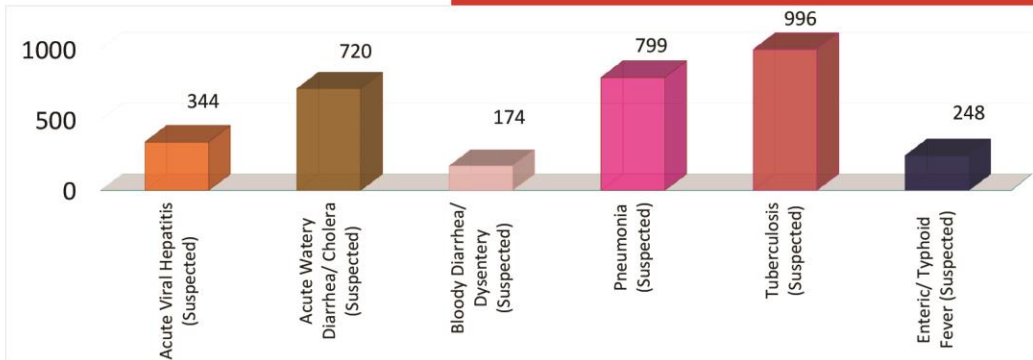


COMMUNICABLE DISEASE SITUATION - PUNJAB (WEEK 12, 2016)

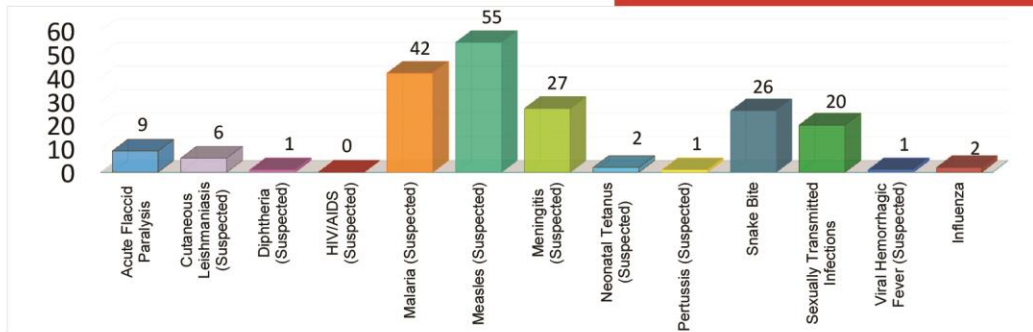
Diseases with number of cases >1000

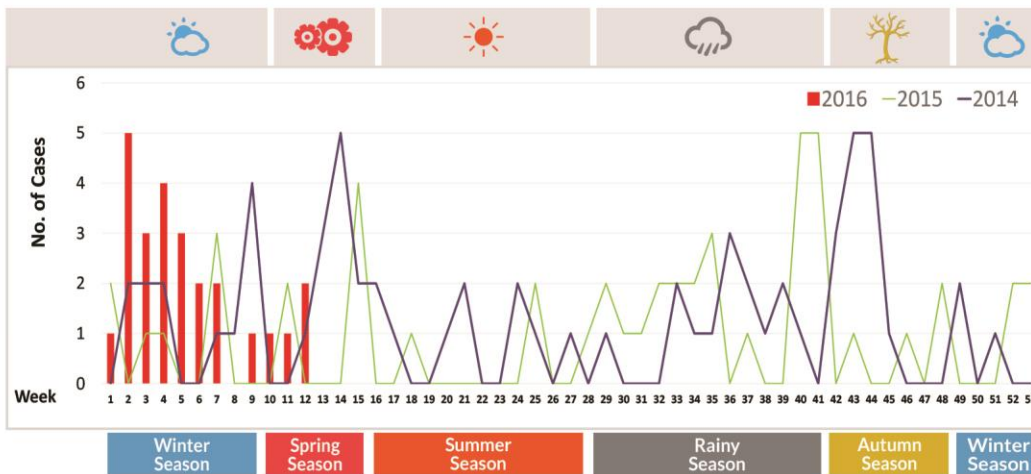

CASE DEFINITION

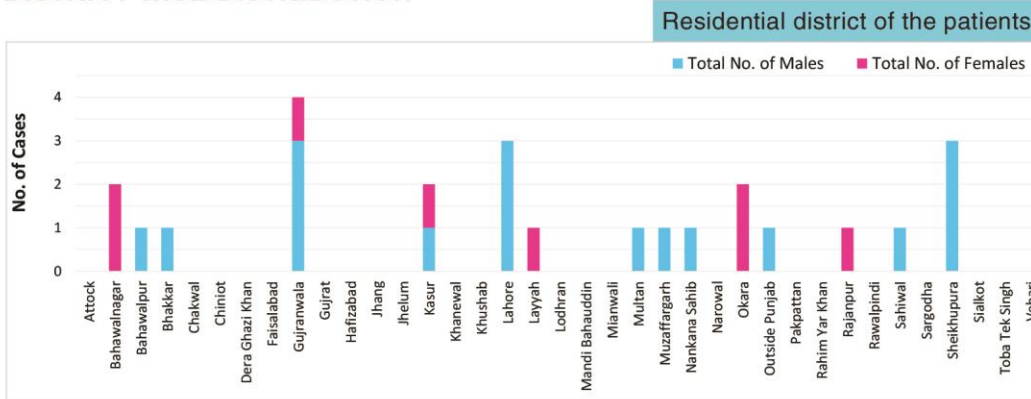
Suspected Case: Any neonatal death between 3 and 28 days of age in which the cause of death is unknown *OR* any neonate reported as suffering from neonatal tetanus and not investigated.

Confirmed Case: Any neonate with normal ability to suck and cry during the first 2 days of life but who between 3 and 28 days of age cannot suck normally and becomes stiff or has convulsions or both. Hospital reported cases are considered confirmed.

DISTRICT WISE DISTRIBUTION



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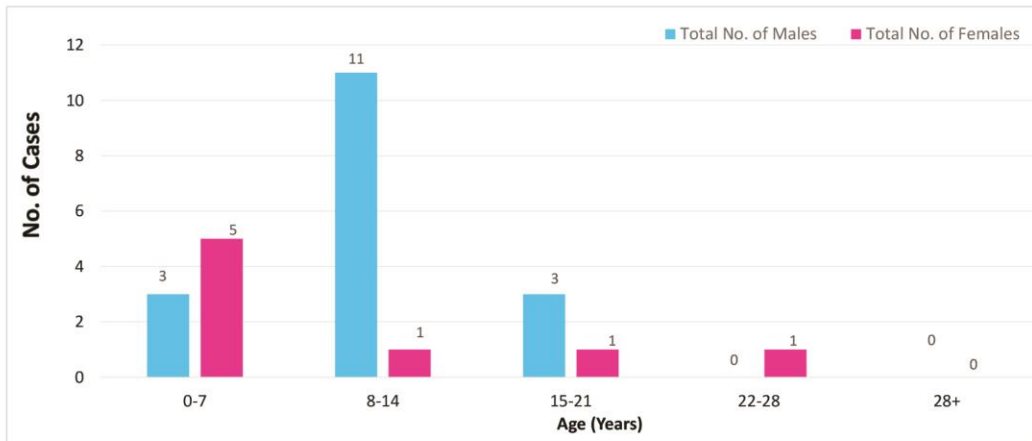

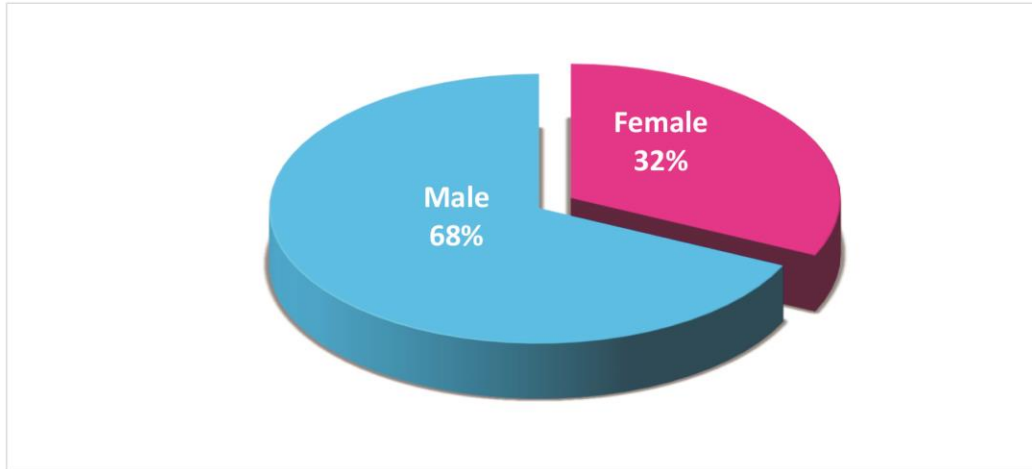

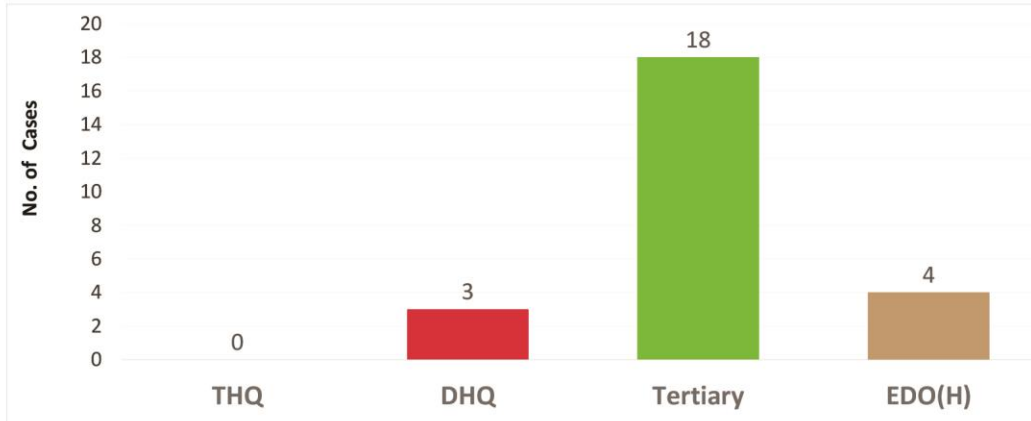

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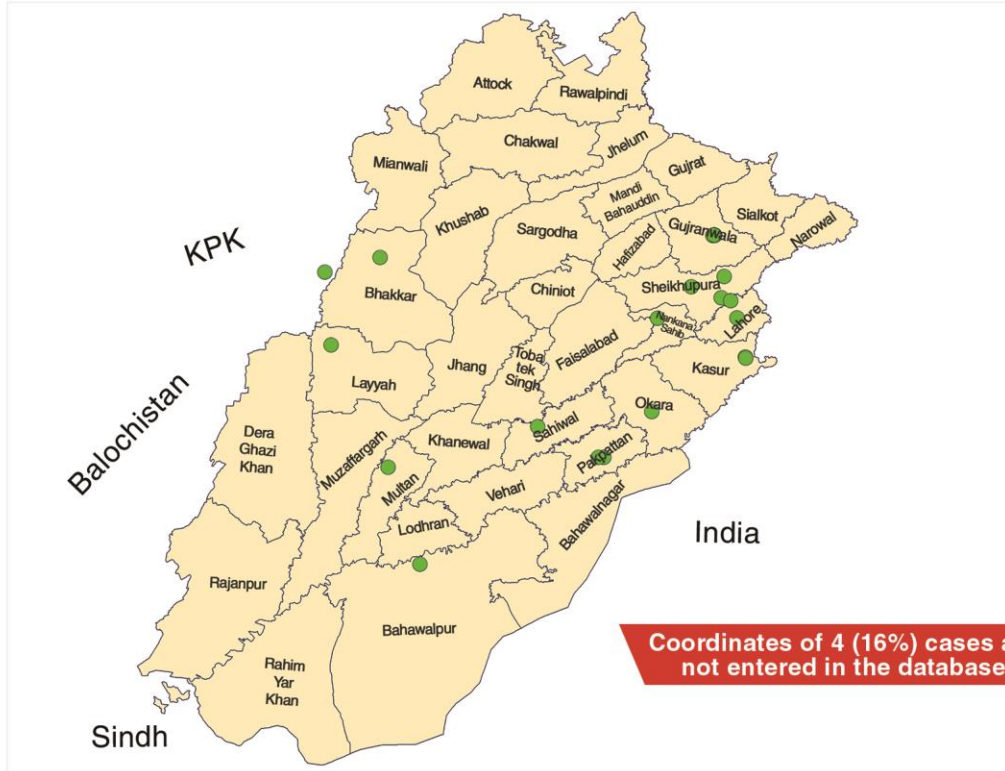

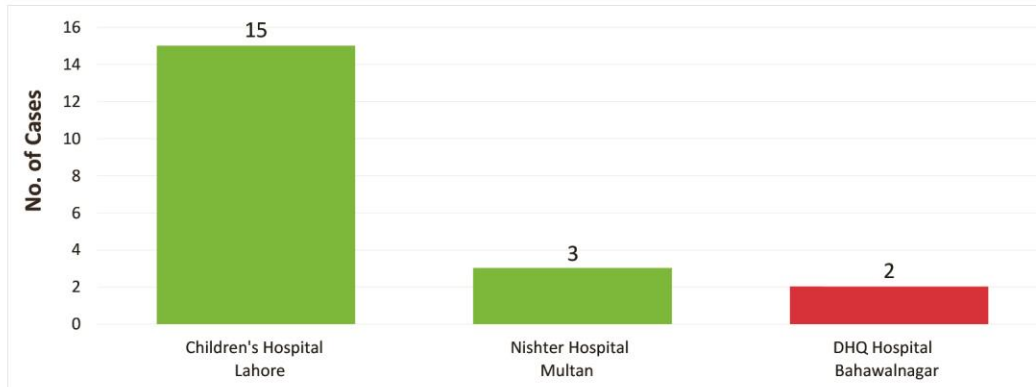

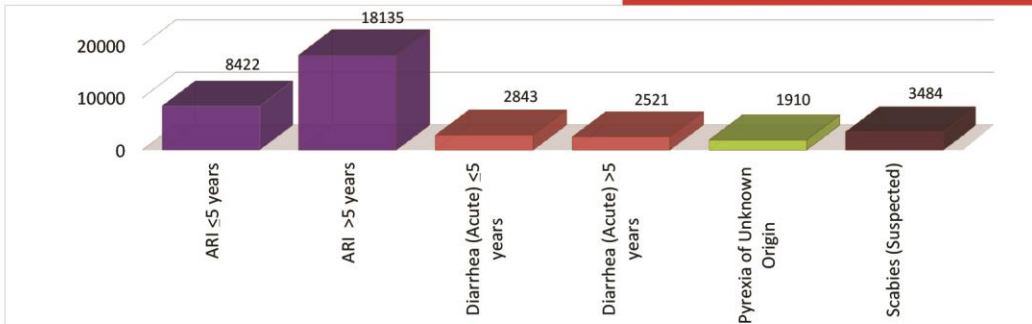

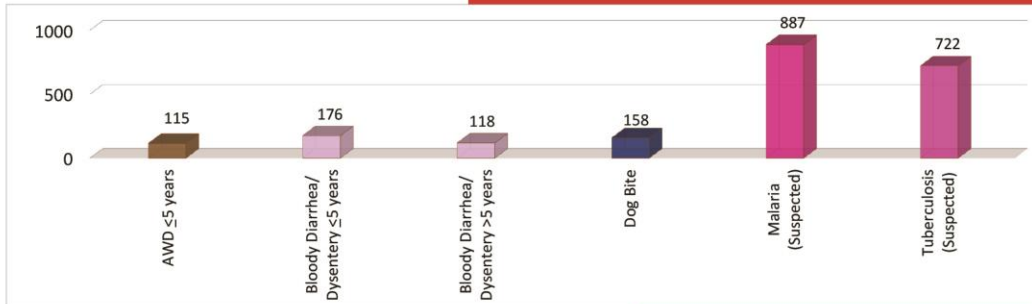


DISEASE WISE DISTRIBUTION

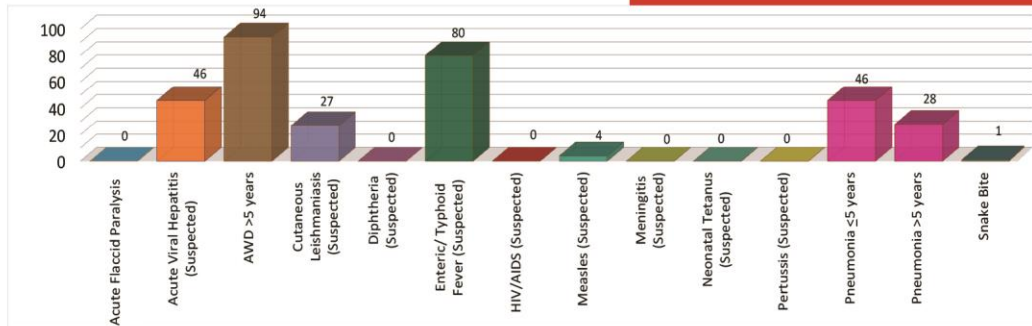
Diseases with number of cases >1000

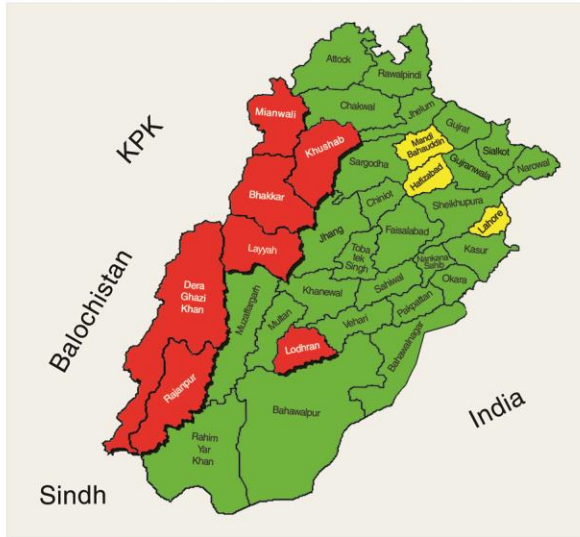
Focusing Disease Wheel

- Response on 4 or more days of the week

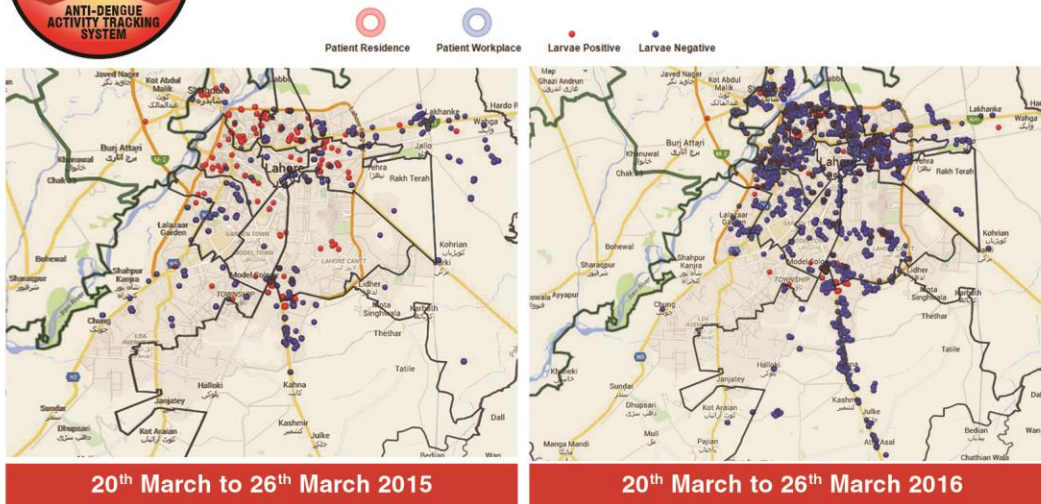


EDO's(H) of the districts with response on less than 4 days of the week (colored red and yellow) must ensure consistent reporting.
