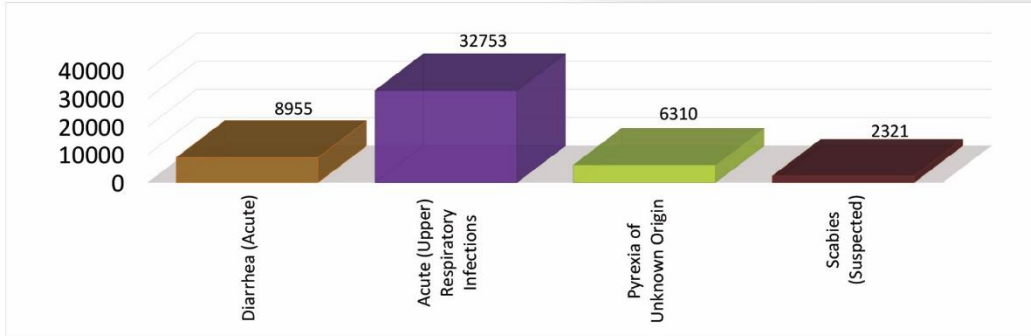

Communicable Disease Situation - Punjab

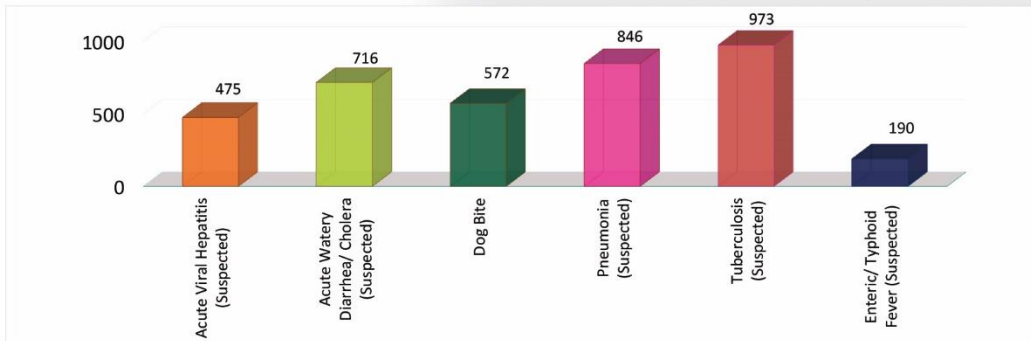

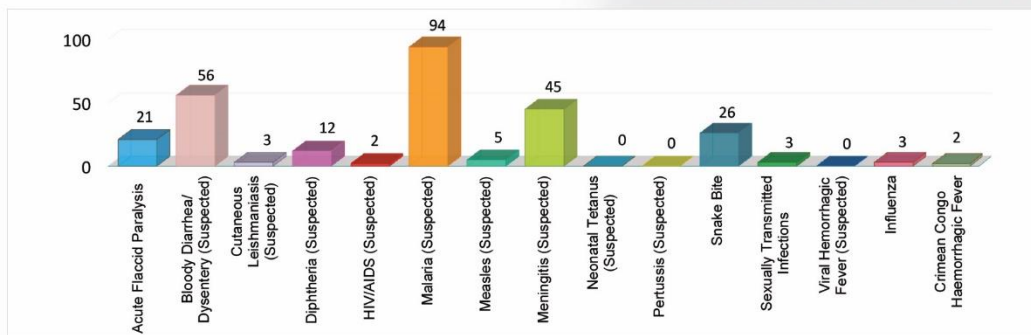
Diseases with number of cases >1000

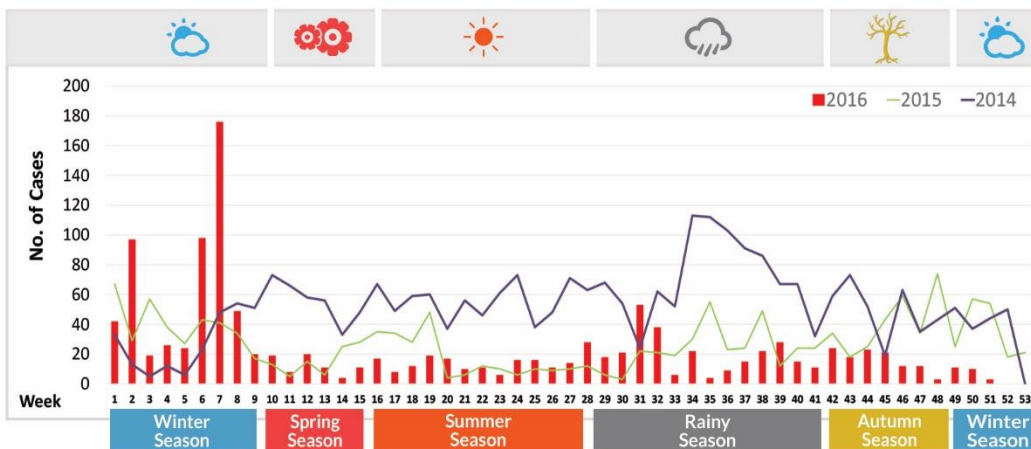

CASE DEFINITION

Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) are infections that are spread primarily through person-to-person sexual contact. There are more than 30 different sexually transmissible bacteria, viruses and parasites.

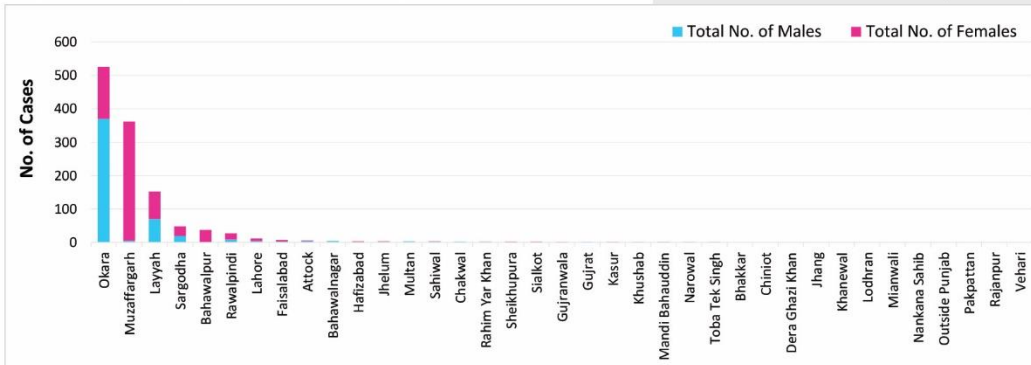
The most common conditions they cause are Gonorrhoea, Chlamydial infection, Syphilis, Trichomoniasis, Chancroid, Genital Herpes, Genital Warts, Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV/AIDS) Infection and Hepatitis B Infection.

DISTRICT WISE DISTRIBUTION

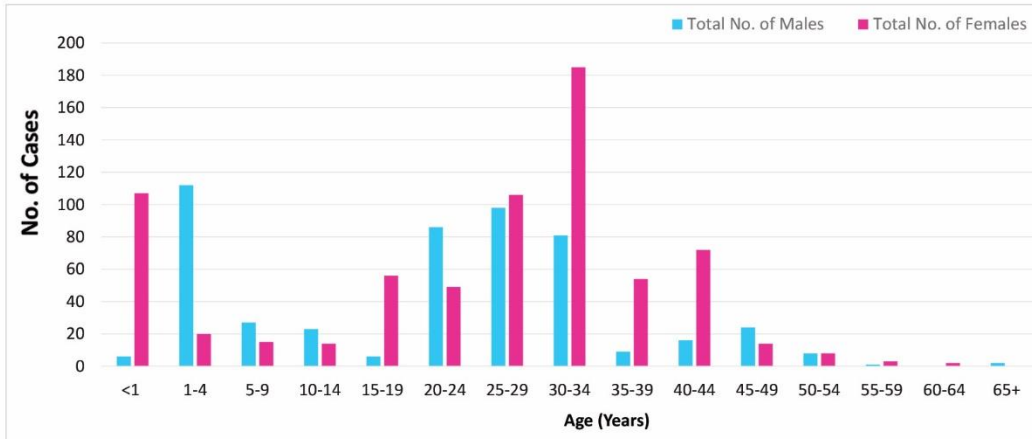

AGE WISE DISTRIBUTION



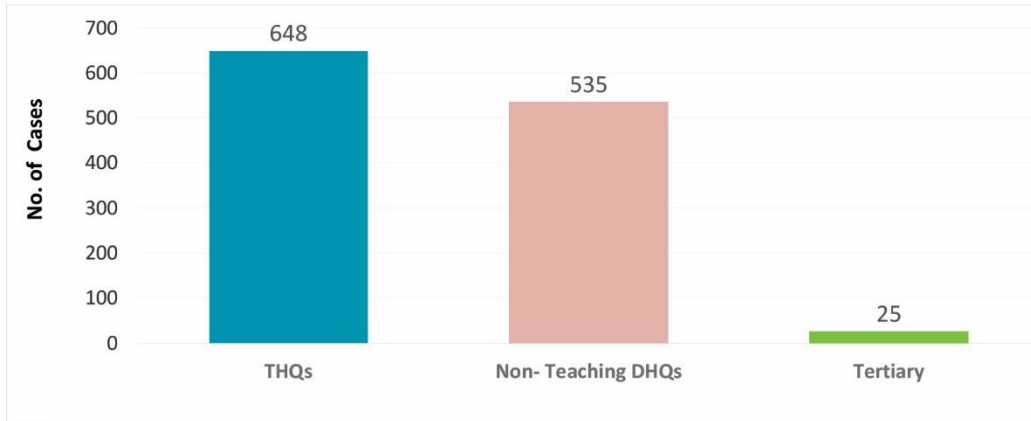
GENDER WISE DISTRIBUTION

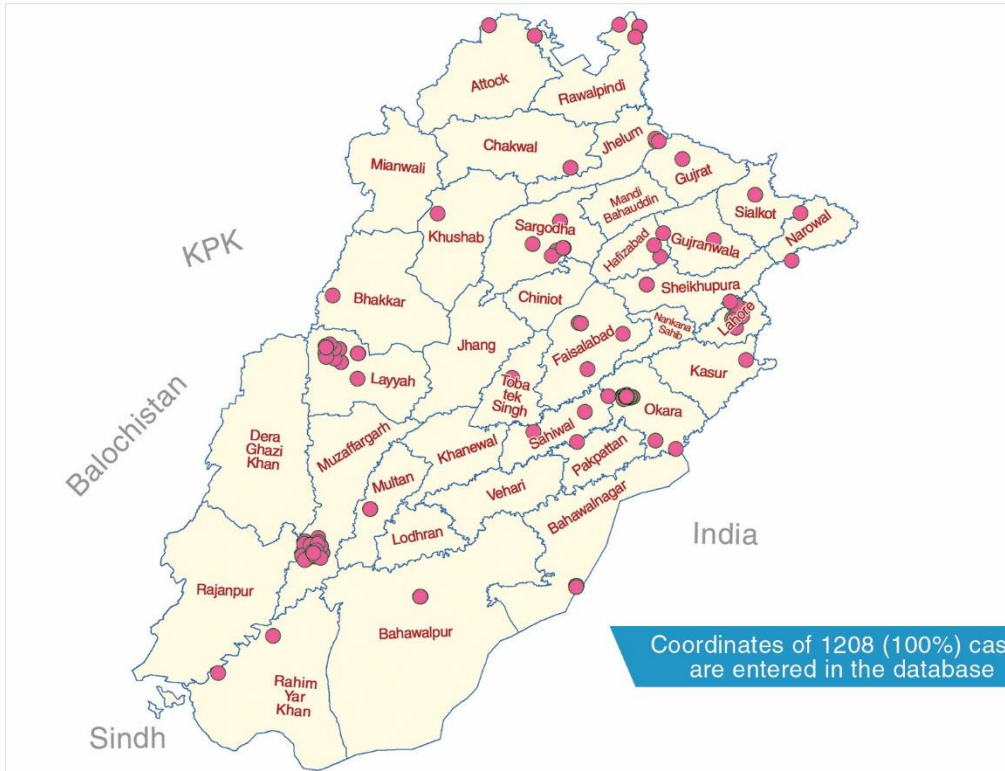

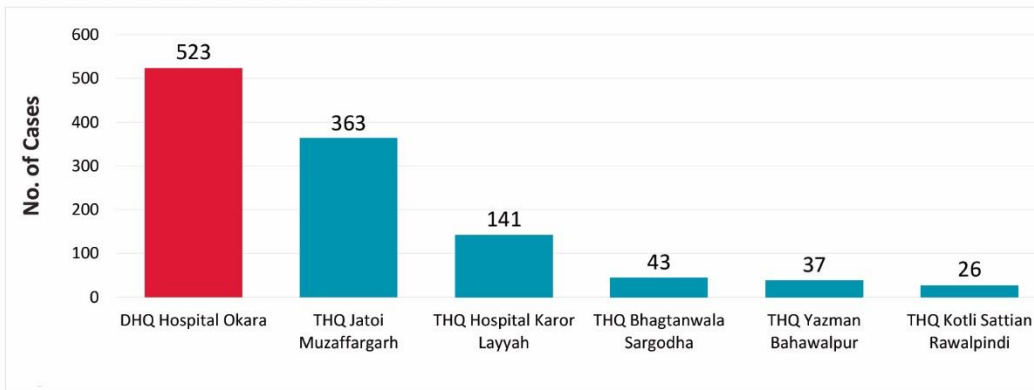

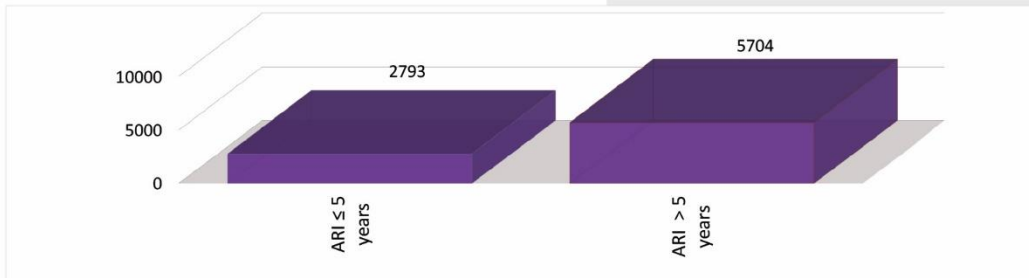
Focusing Disease Wheel

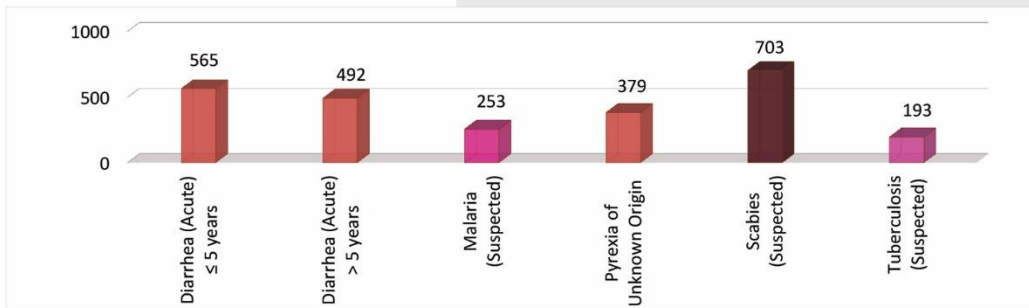

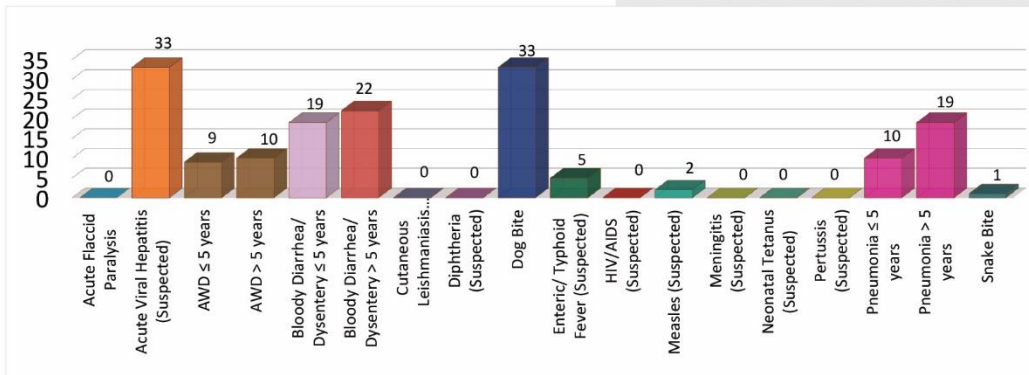
Diseases with number of cases > 1000
