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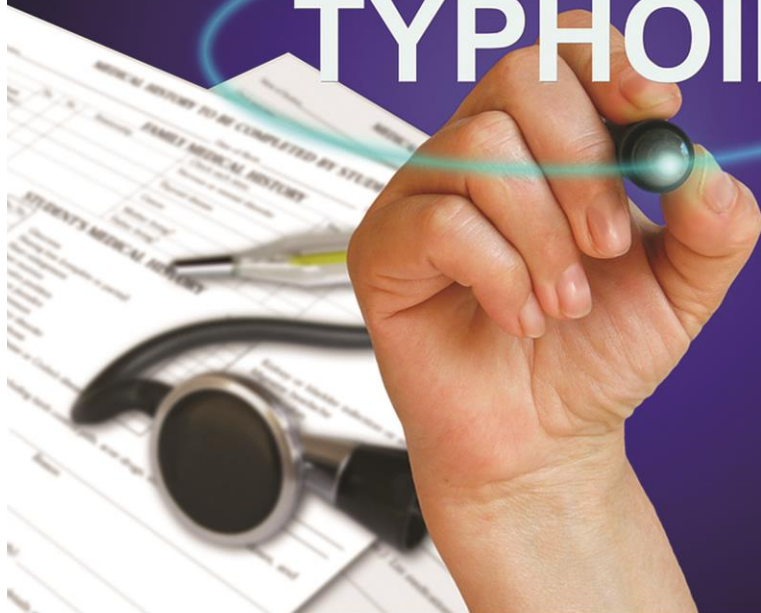

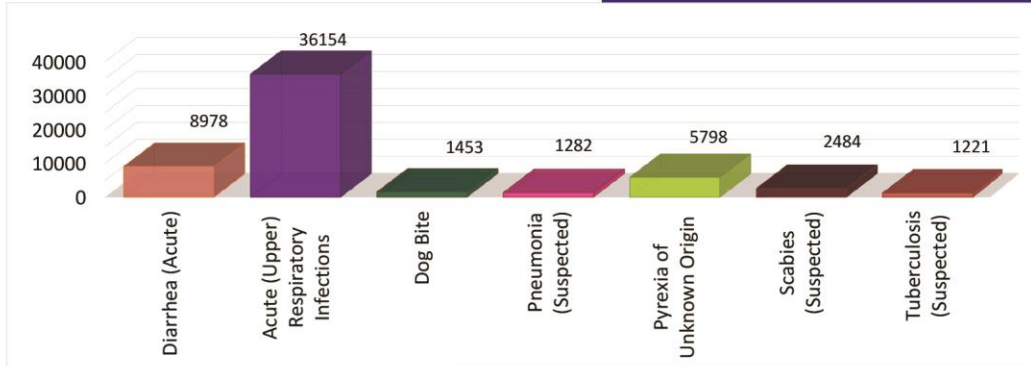

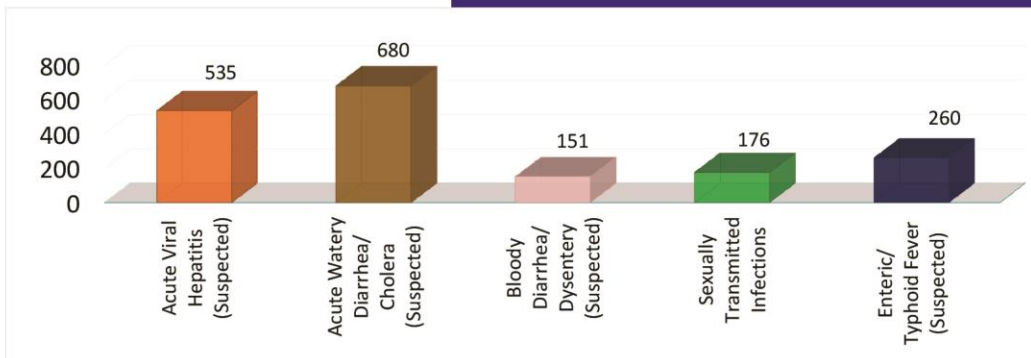

COMMUNICABLE DISEASE SITUATION - PUNJAB (WEEK 7, 2016)

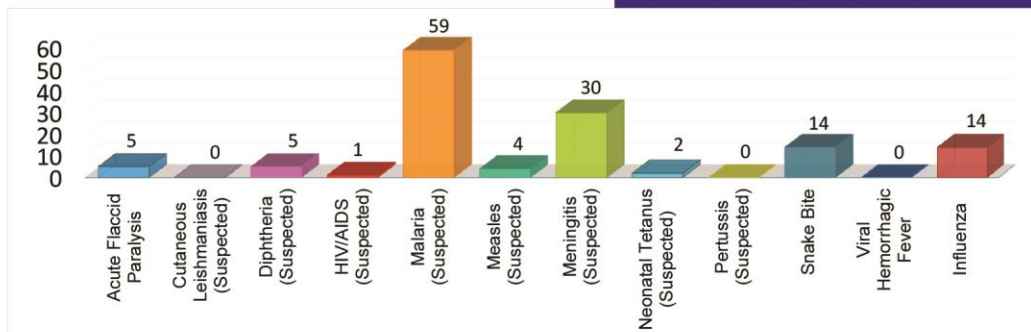
Diseases with number of cases >1000

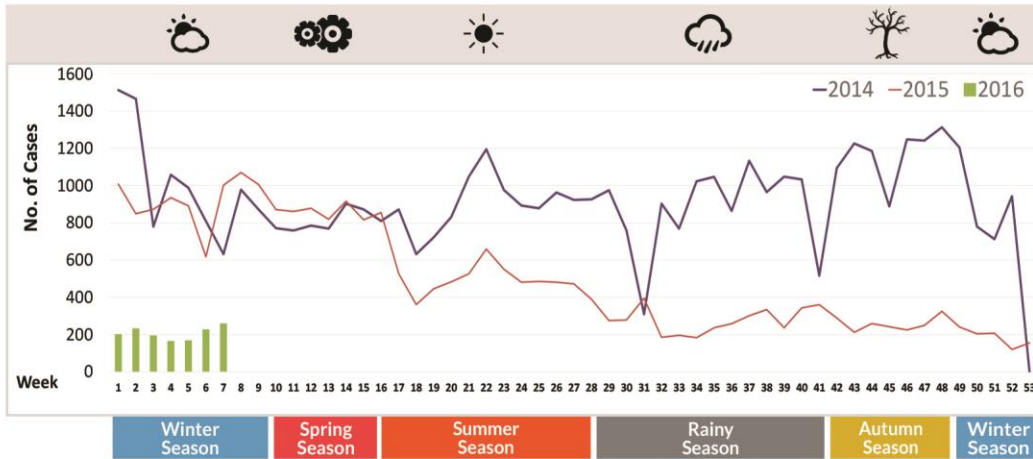

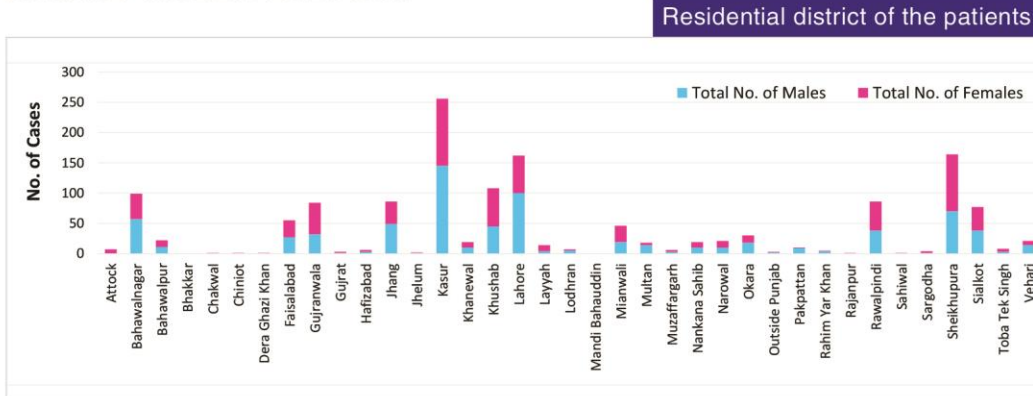
CASE DEFINITION

Suspected Case: Any person with acute illness and demonstrates insidious onset of sustained fever, headache, malaise, anorexia, relative bradycardia, constipation or diarrhea or abdominal tenderness progressing to prostration.

DISTRICT WISE DISTRIBUTION



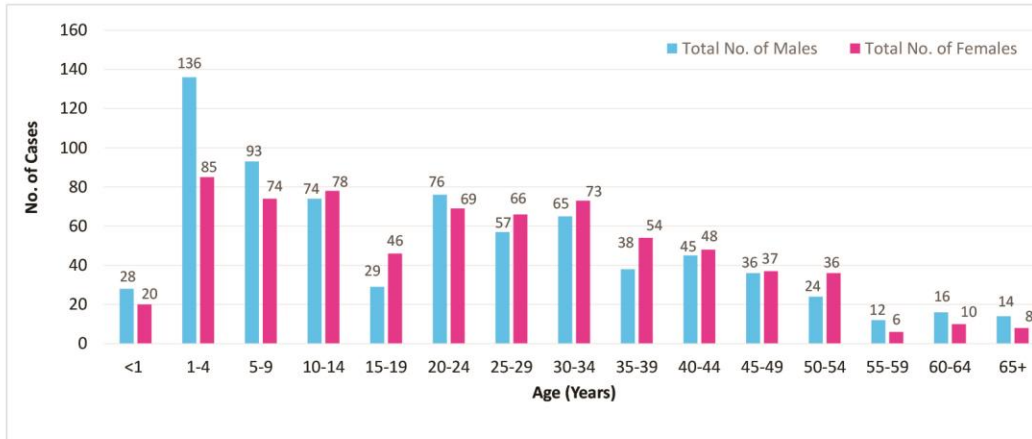

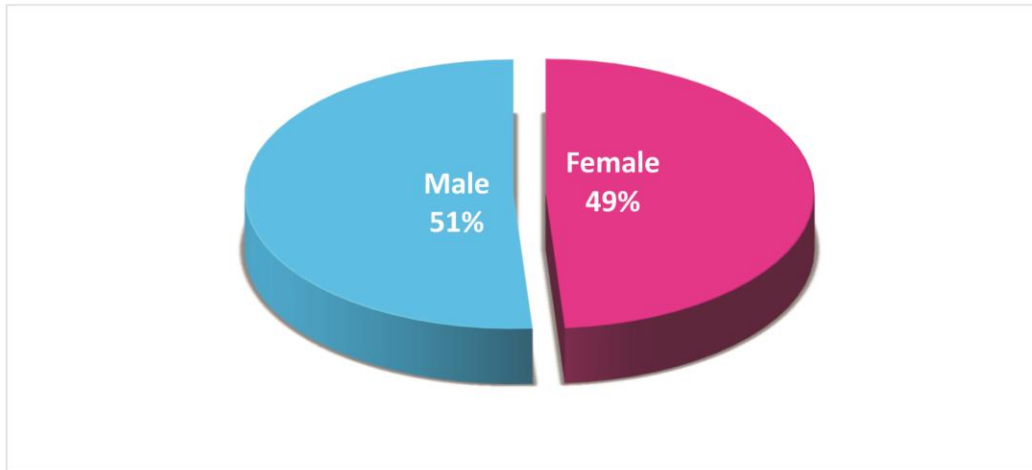
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AGE WISE DISTRIBUTION



GENDER WISE DISTRIBUTION



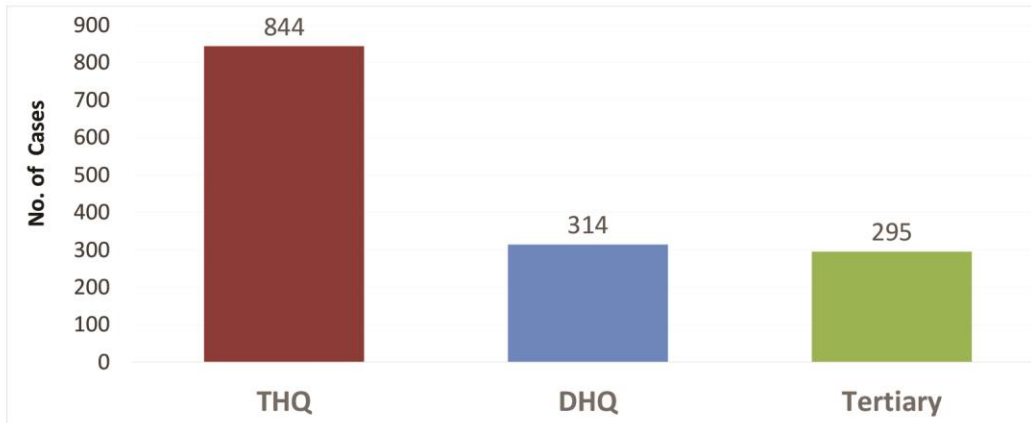

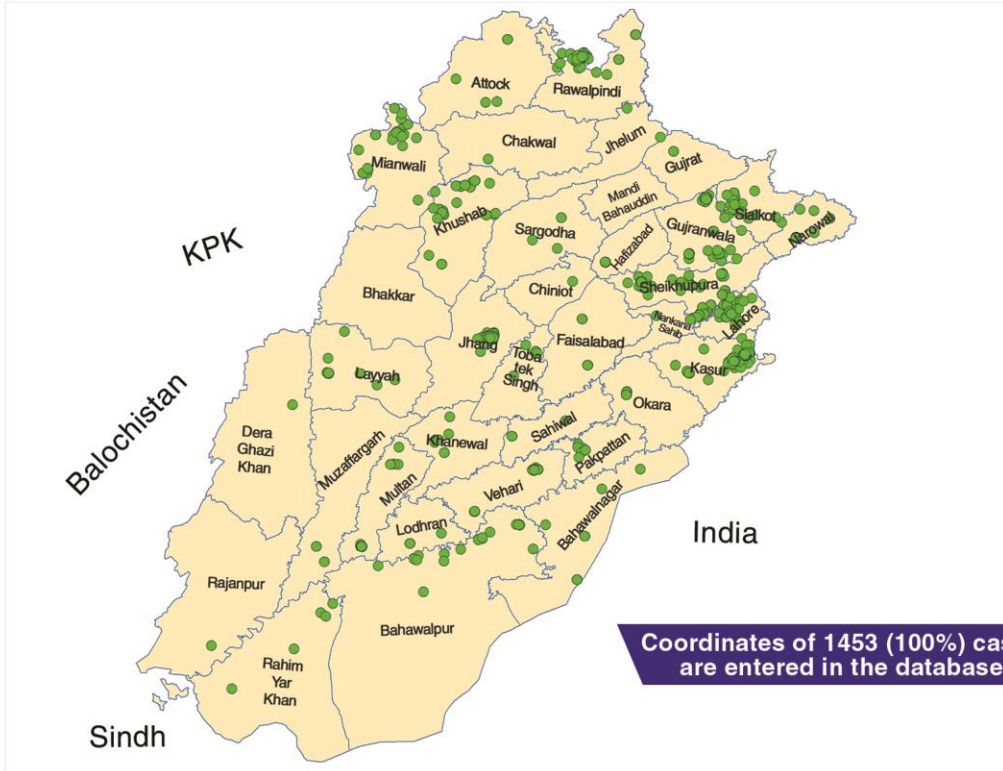

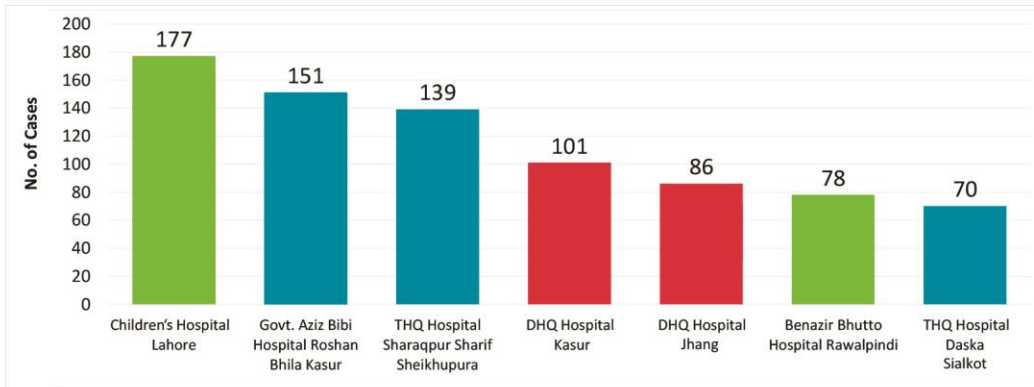

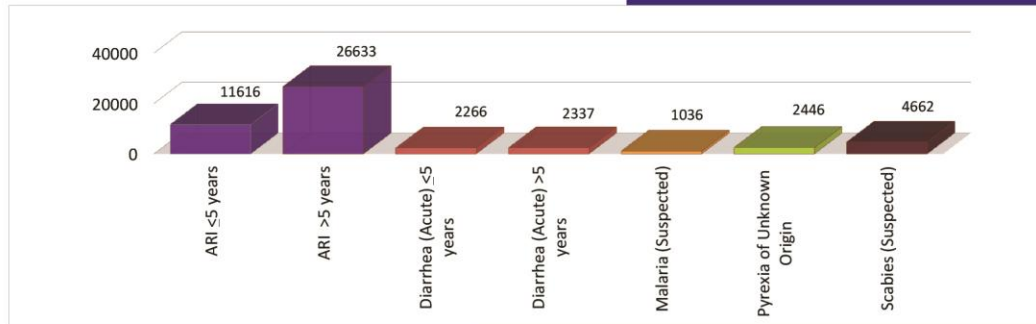

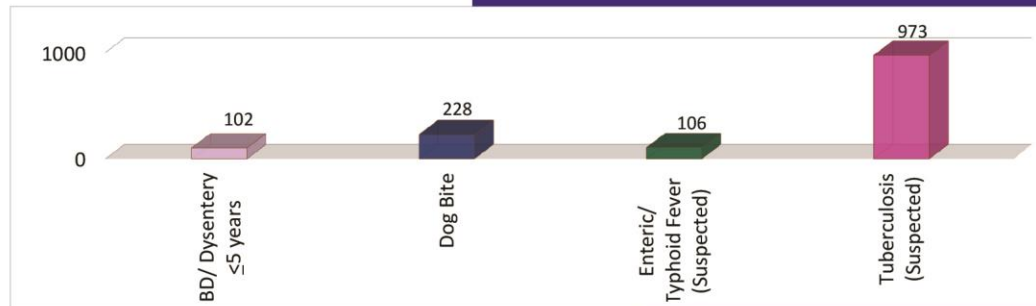


DISEASE WISE DISTRIBUTION

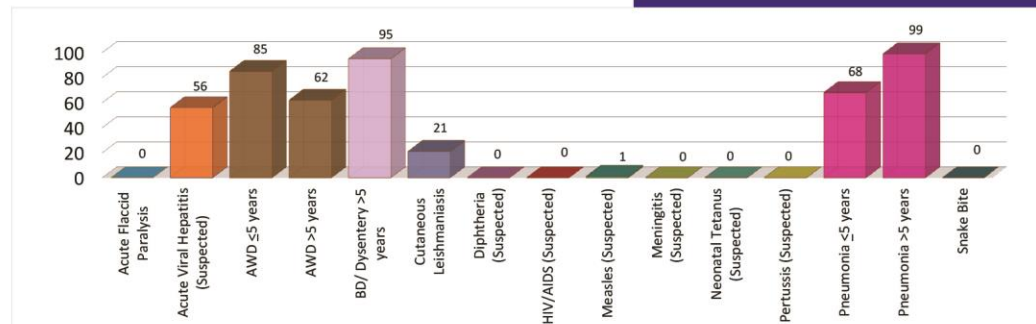
Diseases with number of cases >1000

- Response on 4 or more days of the week

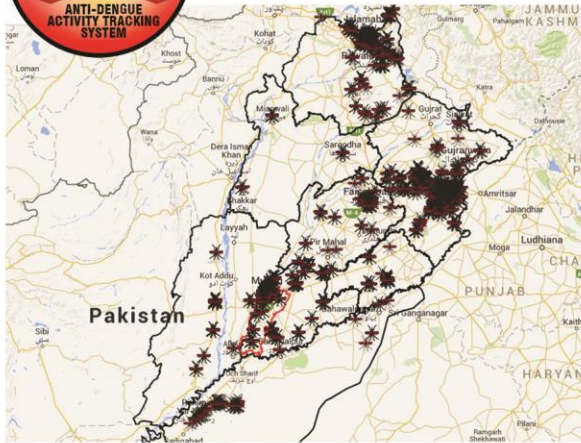


EDO's(H) of the districts with response on less than 4 days of the week (colored red and yellow) must ensure consistent reporting.
