VC ITU OPENS INDEPENDENCE MOVEMENT EXHIBITION

Lahore, August 17, 2017

Dr Umar Saif, Vice Chancellor Information Technology University (ITU) Punjab opened an exhibition to commemorate the 70 Years of Pakistan's independence at the Arfa Software Technology Park curated by the Centre for Governance and Policy ITU here today.

The exhibition will remain open for one month till September 14, 2017, which covers the period from the Lahore Resolution in 1940 to Pakistan's creation and the immediate aftermath.
